Day 1: Pack your bags, hop on the **Travel Tours** coach, sit back and relax on this designed day of travel to **Collinsville, IL** and the **Drury Inn & Suites**. (Snacks & beverages)

Farms & resorts will be decorated with corn shocks, pumpkins and scarecrows galore! Enjoy two nights at the **Inn @ Amish Acres**. This evening feast on a **Thresher’s Meal!** (CB, D)

Day 3: Tour the **Amish Acres 1874 Homestead**, the only Amish Farm listed in the **National Register of Historic Places**. View the documentary films and take a tractor-pulled **Wagon ride** through the farm. See apples being made into cider in the Kuhns Cider Grist Mill. Browse the shops in the courtyard for homemade caramel apples, pumpkin fudge and more! After an **included lunch**, take reserved seats for the **Broadway Musical “Plain & Fancy”**. Enjoy a leisurely dinner & evening at Amish Acres. (CB, L, D)

Day 4: This morning you depart for Mackinaw City, MI, where you board a ferry to the Island for two nights at **Lake View Hotel Mackinac Island**. Swim in their heated pool, take a walk or sit on the porch for a peaceful & relaxing step back in time. (CB, D)

Day 5: Today a **horse drawn carriage ride** will transport you back to a feeling of yesteryear. See the Island’s natural wonders and breathtaking beauty on a leisurely tour. Your carriage will drop you at America’s summer home **The Grand Hotel**, an 1887’s Victorian hotel. Enjoy the grandeur of another era as you partake of their **Luncheon Buffet**. Sit on the porch or take a self-guided tour of this icon of summer resorts before walking or taking a horse-drawn carriage taxi back to the hotel. The island offers numerous other diversions, including Fort Mackinac and a historic village with quaint shops featuring Mackinac’s world-famous fudge. (B, L)

Day 6: Take Shepler’s Ferry back to the mainland, re-board your **Travel Tours** coach, sit back and relax. Get a glimpse of 154 years of maritime history at the **Soo Locks** where freighters, barges, tugboats & more traverse the 21-foot drop between Lake Superior & Lake Huron every day as you **cruise through the locks**. Cross the International



Bridge into **Sault Ste Marie, Ontario** for two nights at the **Quality Inn Bayfront. (B)**

Day 7: All Aboard the **Algoma Central Railroad** for a day-long tour of the **Agawa Canyon**, the oldest mountain range in the world. The Algoma railroad winds its way through an immense stretch of unspoiled wilderness for some wonderful photo opportunities. Enjoy your last evening in Sault Ste Marie. **(B)**

Day 8: This morning visit the **Great Lakes Shipwreck Museum** with artifacts from 13 local shipwrecks and a tribute to the Fitzgerald & the men lost with that vessel, made infamous by the song **“The Wreck of the Edmund Fitzgerald”** by **Gordon Lightfoot**. After an included lunch at **Tahquamenon Falls** view one of the largest waterfalls east of the Mississippi River. On to **Escanaba, MI** and the **Comfort Suites** for the night. **(B, L)**

Day 9: Sit back & relax as you travel to the **Chicago, IL** suburb of **Westchester** for accommodations at the **Hampton Inn**. Enjoy dinner at **Bubba Gump Shrimp Company** at **Navy Pier**, with all the charm & American spirit that made **“Forest Gump”** such a smash hit! On December 4, 1956, an auspicious twist of fate brought together **Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, Carl Perkins & Elvis Presley**. The place was Sun Records’ storefront studio in Memphis. **The Million Dollar Quartet Show** captures the infectious spirit, freewheeling excitement and thrilling sounds of a singular moment when four of popular music’s most extraordinary talents, all in their creative prime, came together for one night that would raise the roof! Experience that moment again at the **Apollo Theatre!!! (CB, D)**

Day 10: This morning visit **Skydeck Chicago**, Chicago’s highest & most visited observatory. You haven’t seen Chicago until you’ve seen it from the Skydeck, formerly

the **Sears Tower**. Travel to **Collinsville, IL** and the **Drury Inn** for the night. **(CB, snacks & beverages)**

Day 11: Arrive in Oklahoma with wonderful memories of old favorites and new attractions visited on this tour. **Travel Tours** looks forward to hosting you again soon to another great destination! **(CB)**

GENERAL INFORMATION

How To Come Along on Travel Tours Trips-Send full name, address and **\$50.00** per person (unless individual tour specified) deposit to Travel Tours, Box 40, Wagoner, OK 74477-0040. **Balance is due no later than six (6) weeks prior to departure** (Statements will not be mailed out). Please identify the tour number.

Cancellation and Refund Policy - All cancellations **MUST** be made during normal business hours. Unless specified otherwise, cancellations made more than 31 days prior to departure will be entitled to a full refund, less any special event tickets that had to be pre-purchased. For cancellation made less than 31 days but more than 48 hours prior to departure, there will be a 10% cancellation fee plus any non-refundable expenses incurred by Travel Tours for hotels, attractions, transportation or other supplies related to the tour. No refunds will be issued for cancellation made within 48 hours of departure. If you are forced to leave a tour after departure, no refunds will be given for unused portions. To safeguard against unforeseen circum-

stances we suggest travelers obtain travel insurance.

Early Booking Discount (EBD) - The EBD is a discount that is earned when you book on a tour and remit your deposit a minimum of 60 days in advance of the tour departure date. Most of our tours have an EBD and it is typically listed with the tour pricing.

Insurance - Travel Tours cannot assume liability for lost or damaged luggage. Baggage insurance is available through Travel Tours. Trip cancellation and accident insurance is recommended and may be obtained through the Travel Tours Office.

Membership - Tour membership is open to all persons ages 5 and up, however, we reserve the right to reject or terminate the membership of any person whom Travel Tours may consider objectionable to the tour. Applicants with a disability are welcome on our tours. If you have a disability and would like to request specific accommodation,

please notify us, in advance of the tour, so we can try to make the necessary arrangements.
